## Start a conversation about learning...

Why not take your child by surprise and ask a specific question about their learning!

- At the moment in the Grevillia Neighbourhood we are learning about the following things:
- Using the range of reading strategies we know including; predicting, making connections, questioning, visualising, identifying the genre, message or moral.
  - You could ask your child to show you how they can complete a Reader's notebook style page, using these strategies.
  - Multiplication and Division equations.
  - Integrated studies- Discuss with your child all the states and capital cities in Australia and look at maps of Australia and the world.
  - Writing- we are learning about procedural writing and journal/diary writing.
  - Encourage your child to log on to Essential Assessment and complete My Numeracy activities

## How to help your child learn at home:

- Involve your child in as many hands on activities as possible such as cooking, telling the time, playing board games counting and using money.
- At the end of the day ask your child specific questions about their learning.
- Which reading strategy are you focussing on at the moment?
- Which book did you read?
- What are you learning about in maths?
- What was your favourite part of the day?
- What were you proud of today?
