In Writing we have been completing information reports about bushfires, floods, cyclones, droughts and earthquakes and have started writing persuasive pieces about preferred modes of transport.




In Maths this term we have been looking at arrays in multiplication and have just started on division.

to observe and describe the features of modern and prehistoric living things. They make comparisons and claims about where animals might live, what they might eat and how they might move. Students' questions and ideas
